

T-BALL DIVISION - Pre-K and Kindergarten (split) - UGSA

Distance between bases: 45 Feet - Ball: T-Ball

No new inning is to start after 50 minutes. Games can either be 2 or 3 innings, decided by coaches due to factors including temperature and/or length of time of innings. Three innings games are preferred if possible within 50 minutes. If heat rules are in effect, a HARD STOP time may be issued (end game at a certain time even if inning is not complete).

1. GENERAL RULES

- 1. T-Ball division is for girls who are 3 prior to April 1st; through Kindergarten. **We recommend kindergartners who have played before play in the Kittens division**
- 2. The field will be set up by members of the UGSA. Both teams that have the last game will be responsible for putting away the tee.
- 3. All games will be played at the fields designated by UGSA Board
- 4. Players and coaches must wear athletic or tennis shoes. No metal cleats, flip flops, open toe or open back shoes are allowed. Players are not allowed to wear jewelry.
- 5. Game time will be approximately 50 minutes. Umpiring will be done by the coaches.
- 6. Rainouts: If two innings are completed, the game is over. If not, the game will be rescheduled starting where the game previously stopped.
- 7. All batters and runners must wear protective head gear with chin strap. Players must not remove helmet while on the field.
- 8. No score will be kept. Both teams will be declared the winner in each game.
- 9. A line will be marked three feet in front of the batting tee. A batted ball that does not pass this line will be declared a dead ball.
- 10. Each team will field all players each inning. Managers must rotate girls so that all have a chance to try different positions.
- 11. A coach may be in the field for defense only.
- 12. Each team will bat through their entire line-up each half inning, no matter how many runs or outs are made.
- 13. A girl who is out must leave the base and return to the dugout.
- 14. The runner will stay on the base until the ball is hit.
- 15. A runner is not allowed to advance on an overthrow.
- 16. Runners who are less than ½ way to the next base when a fielder has control of the ball must return to the previous base.
- 17. The infield fly rule is not in effect for this division.
- 18. At discretion of coaches, 3 balls may be pitched to the batter if considered advanced. After 3 pitches, batting tee will be used
